The documentation outlined below is required to prove residency.

One set of documents is required per family.

If you do not own, lease or rent, please contact the Residency Department for a Student Residency Affidavit form.

# LESSEES/ RENTERS

#### **MUST HAVE:**

A current signed Affirmation of Residency

#### AND

# **TWO** of the following:

- Current State of Illinois Vehicle Registration; not Driver's License
- Current copy of electric bill (e.g. ComEd);
- Current copy of gas bill (e.g. Nicor); or
- Other current Utility bill

#### AND

## **ONE** of the following:

- Proof of payment of current real estate taxes (e.g. canceled check or Cook County Collector receipt); or
- Current installment of Real Estate Tax Bill (from Cook County Treasurer website);
   or
- Current homeowner's insurance policy showing name, insured address and policy period of homeowner; or
- For new homeowners <u>only</u>, as a substitute for one of the above, Settlement Statement from closing documents. (This option is available for families who have recently closed on their homes and have not yet received a current property tax bill.)

#### **MUST HAVE:**

A current signed Affirmation of Residency

#### **AND**

# **TWO** of the following:

- Current State of Illinois Vehicle Registration; not Driver's License
- Current copy of electric bill (e.g. ComEd);
- Current copy of gas bill (e.g. Nicor); or
- Other current Utility bill

### **AND**

### ONE of the following:

- Your valid current lease (signed and dated) or a statement from your landlord (signed and dated); or
- Proof of rent payments for the last two months (e.g. canceled checks, receipts, or a signed and dated statement from your landlord (which must include your landlord's phone number); or
- Current rental insurance policy showing name, insured address and policy period of resident/policy holder

- If you've just moved in & bills are not available at the time of registration: please provide documentation confirming that your utility services have been scheduled in your new home.
- Documentation should not have expired prior to the first day of school. Additional documentation may be requested as deemed necessary on a case-by-case basis.
