Dear Parents,

For the purpose of safeguarding the health of children, Glenview School District 34 enforces Illinois student health requirements.

### **Students in Kindergarten OR first-time students in the District**

Physical Examination Form (must be done within previous 12 months) including Immunization record

Eye Examination Form prior to October 15<sup>th</sup> of the current school year (must be done within previous 12 months)

Dental Examination Form prior to May 15<sup>th</sup> of the current school year (must be done within previous 18 months)

### **Students in 2nd Grade**

Dental Examination Form prior to May 15<sup>th</sup> of the current school year (must be done within previous 18 months)

### **Students in 6th Grade**

Physical Examination Form (must be done within previous 12 months) including Immunization record

Dental Examination Form prior to May 15<sup>th</sup> of the current school year (must be done within previous 18 months)

## **Your child will not be able to start school until the required Physical Examination/Immunization Form is turned in.**

Please upload the [Physical Exam/Immunization Record](#) into the [District 34 Portal](#) by August 14, 2026.

If you are unable to upload the physical examination, you may drop it off **at your school's health office before the end of the school year or at the district office over the summer.**

If a child fails to present proof of an eye or dental exam by the above timeline, the school may hold the child's report card until one (or more, if applicable) of the following occur:

- child presents proof of a completed examination
- child presents proof that an eye examination will take place within 60 days after October 15
- child presents proof that a dental examination will take place within 60 days after May 15
- child presents a dental or eye examination waiver
- child presents an exemption based on religious grounds

District 34 is working with the Ronald McDonald House to provide physical examinations and vaccinations for those needing financial assistance. Please contact your school nurse for more information.
